Where there has been mould, treat the area with a moss and mould remover. Stir well before and during use with a broad, flat paddle, using an up and down scooping motion.

- Rolling – a 6-10mm microfibre or dacron roller sleeve is recommended

When rolling walls that are highlighted by natural lighting from large windows, you will need to 'lay off' with the roller in one direction after applying the paint. This should be done in one continuous operation from one end of the wall to the other without stopping. For large areas, two applicators may be required – one to lay on the paint, and one to 'lay off'.

Timber, particle board, customwood

- 1. Apply 1 coat of Aalto Ultra Premium 3 in 1 Undercoat
- 2. Apply 2 coats of Aalto Tradeline Waterbased Enamel Flat, allowing 2-4 hours between coats

Wallboard, Gib[®] board

- 1. Apply 1 coat of Aalto Tradeline Interior Sealer Undercoat
- 2. Apply 2 coats of Aalto Tradeline Waterbased Enamel Flat, allowing 2-4 hours between coats

New fibrous plaster

- 1. Apply 1 coat of Procoat by Aalto Pigmented Sealer
- 2. Apply 2 coats of Aalto Tradeline Waterbased Enamel Flat Gloss, allowing 2-4 hours between coats

Repaints

- 1. Spot prime if/where required with Aalto Ultra Premium 3 in 1 Undercoat
- 2. Apply 2 coats of Aalto Tradeline Waterbased Enamel Flat Gloss, allowing 2-4 hours between coats

Maintenance

Maintain your interior paint finish by cleaning with a damp cloth and neutral detergent (such as diluted sugar soap). Cleaners that contain solvents may affect the surface appearance and the paints longevity. Dry dust corners frequently to avoid dust and dirt build up.

Performance and Limitations

Performance

- Can be used in place of traditional oil based enamels
- Non-yellowing
- Easy application properties, with excellent flow and levelling
- Excellent durability in high service areas

Limitations

- Should not be applied if temperatures are below 10°C or when it is liable to drop below 10°C during the drying period
- Dry time may be extended if the relative humidity is high
- After application, allow 12-48 hours before the area becomes fully serviceable, with full hardness developing after 1-3 weeks
