Preparation

Ensure surfaces are free from loose and flaking paint. Wash surfaces with a suitable cleaner such as sugar soap prior to painting to remove dirt, oils, grease and other contaminants. Where there has been mould, treat the area with a moss and mould remover.

Stir well before and during use with a broad, flat paddle, using an up and down scooping motion.

Application

Aalto Primer Sealer Undercoat can be applied by synthetic brush, roller, or spray.

- Airless spray a 415 or 515 tip is recommended
- Rolling a 8-10mm microfibre or Dacron roller sleeve is recommended



# Bare timber, plywood, particle board

- 1. Sand bare timber and dust off
- 2. Apply 1 coat of Aalto Primer Sealer Undercoat, followed by 2 topcoats

#### Bare Zincalume®, galvanised iron

- 1. Treat with appropriate cleaning solution to remove oils, grease
- 2. If there are any areas of rust, remove and spot prime with Procoat by Aalto Etch Primer
- 3. Apply 1 coat of Aalto Primer Sealer Undercoat, followed by 2 topcoats

#### Old enamels, polyurethane

- Lightly sand surface and dust off
- 2. Wash well with sugar soap, rinse and allow to dry
- 3. Apply 1 coat of Aalto Primer Sealer Undercoat, followed by 2 topcoats

#### Tannin stains

1. Apply 1 coat of Aalto Primer Sealer Undercoat, followed by 2 topcoats

# Tannin stains - heavy

- 1. Apply 2 coats of Aalto Primer Sealer Undercoat, allowing 2 hours between coats
- 2. Apply 2 coats of topcoat

# Crayon, graffiti, light smoke stains, water stains, fly spots

- 1. Wash the area thoroughly to remove as much of the stain as possible
- 2. Apply 1 coat of Aalto Primer Sealer Undercoat, followed by 2 topcoats

# Vinyl wallpapers

1. Apply 1 coat of Aalto Primer Sealer Undercoat, followed by 2 topcoats

#### Maintenance

Maintain your interior paint finish by cleaning with a damp cloth and neutral detergent (such as diluted sugar soap). Cleaners that contain solvents may affect the surface appearance and the paints longevity. Dry dust corners frequently to avoid dust and dirt build up.

Maintain your exterior paint surface by washing it every 12 months (after each winter is a great time), with a suitable exterior cleaner to remove dirt deposits. We do not recommend the use of bleach as this can affect the appearance of the colour over time. Dirt, salt, and bird deposits left on the paint surface will encourage the growth of mould, and affect the paints performance.

# Performance

- Exceptional adhesion
- Excellent holdout for topcoats
- Fast drying
- Dries to a smooth finish

# Limitations

- Should not be applied if temperatures are below 10°C or when it is liable to drop below 10°C during the
  drying period
- Dry time may be extended if the relative humidity is high
- Not to be used as a primer on roof or floor areas where ponding water is present
- High plasticised and metallic embossed wallpapers should be tested in a small area before application
